What can I do next as:

A beginner

- Start a personal learning folder.

What can my organisation do for:

Beginners

- Download the palliAGED Embedding Palliative Care Learning in Practice Service Solution, for four easy steps to implementing palliative care training and evaluation for beginners through to advanced learners
- Order palliAGED Practice Tip Sheet booklets for all staff members as part of induction.
- Ask to install palliAGED Introduction Modules onto the local LMS.

Intermediate learners
